100th Anniversary Plans

Tents have been ordered as well as 42 tables and 336 chairs to provide seating and shelter on the parking lot beside the church. Overflow area for seating will be in Glenn Hall. Noon Mass will be offered by Bishop Zubik. Invited and honored guests will include priests who has served, or been affiliated with St. Paul, government officials, along with diocesan officials, and possible others such as past sisters who lived/helped at St. Paul. Things to do:

Determine exit procedures after Mass, to expedite lines for the social gathering. Once determined, this procedure should be mentioned a few weeks prior to the event in the bulletin so parishioners can plan accordingly. Also to be mentioned will be the agenda for the day. Mass Noon-1:30, Social Gathering Following Mass – 3PM.

Ellen has contacted many caterers, but has not made a decision. Lori will contact Jodi's Pantry and report the cost of finger food/canapés. Ellen has made arrangements for 170 dozen cookies. Karen Geibel will oversee the greeters who will help welcome visitors and honored guests and answer any questions and give directions. Invitations and programs are being done by the office staff. Discussion was held on the possibility of having Holy Cards with a picture of the church made to commemorate the Anniversary. The set up diagram of the tables/chairs under the tent and in Glenn Hall will be done by Bob Seibel. Deacon Mitch will contact the Knights of Columbus for their support and presence during the festivities. Dottie Thomas will provide the decoration of the tent/tables and paper products for the day.

Since there is not a chairperson/s for this event, members will contact individuals/groups for their support. Needed are people to help replenish food and drinks on the tables and clean up. Mentioned were the Youth Group, Boy Scouts, Confirmation class. Ellen will ask Ralph Swain if he can gather help from these groups. A table, possibly set up in the elevator area, will be set up for the sale of commemorative items such as the coffee table book, DVD's etc. Father expressed his support of having a photographer for the day, Denny Hemphill was mentioned, but not contacted.
